Mathieu Jaminet has consistently staked his claim for greater things since 2017. The Frenchman gained his first experiences in the Porsche 911 GT3 R, most notably in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship and the ADAC GT Masters. In 2018, Jaminet joined forces with works drivers Earl Bamber and Laurens Vanthoor to contest Petit Le Mans at Road Atlanta in the Porsche 911 RSR. For the 2019 season, the trio will stay together to compete for the North American Endurance Cup (NAEC) at Daytona, Sebring, Watkins Glen and at Road Atlanta. Moreover, Jaminet will contest the 24 Hours of Le Mans in the Porsche 911 RSR as well as all five rounds of the Intercontinental GT Challenge in the Porsche 911 GT3 R.
